At the Tuesday assembly this week we watched the opening part of a Brother Francis DVD. It defines the Rosary as "A SPECIAL WAY TO PRAY".

Prayer, of course, is very special to us and for us. It has to be seen as God's invitation to engage with Him in relationship.

The word "ACTS (= the abbreviations A.C.T.S.) is a very helpful summary of the purpose of prayer.

'A' is for ADORATION. Firstly, we adore God, simply for being God.

'C' is for CONFESSION (or Contrition). We confess that we cannot be as good or great as God.

'T' is for THANKSGIVING. We thank Him for His gifts and graces up to now.

Finally, 'S' is for SUPPLICATION. We ask Him to supply all our needs.
