Fr Con's Reflection

This month of July does not have any major feast days.

In this respect, it is quite different from June.

June contained 3 major Sunday feasts:

Pentecost (the Descent of the Holy Spirit). The Most Holy Trinity.

Corpus Christi (the feast of Holy Communion).

June is the month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Less well known is the fact that July is the month of the Precious Blood.

Now, of course, there is a very close connection between those two themes.

Sacred scripture tells us that when Jesus' side was pierced upon the cross, blood and

water poured out. (The human heart is encased in a water sac).



His precious Blood is the source of our salvation.

So, in terms of our faith, July is very much a continuation of June.
