Reading for Pleasure

We have been working in class on developing reading skills and increasing the number of children who read for pleasure.

Evidence suggests that there is a positive relationship between reading frequency, reading enjoyment and attainment.

Other benefits to reading for pleasure include: text comprehension and grammar, positive reading attitudes, pleasure in reading in later life and increased general knowledge.

Reading is reading—it doesn't matter what children read as long as they read! Text messages, magazines, websites, newspapers, fiction and non-fiction books, comics and the Pickatale app are common reading choices for children when reading for pleasure.

Please encourage your child to read as much as possible at home, not just their

reading book, but other things as well as this will really help them at school. Please speak to your child's class teacher if you need any help or advice.
