#### Fr Con's Reflection

This coming Sunday, December 12<sup>th</sup> is GAUDETE SUNDAY. It is, by custom, the 3<sup>rd</sup> SUNDAY OF ADVENT.



"GAUDETE" (phonetically GAU-DAY-TAY) is Latin for "REJOICE". It is a word of exhortation.

It points towards December 17<sup>th</sup>, each year in the calendar. That is the day that marks the beginning of the second of Advent's two phases.

The theme of phase 2 of Advent is "REJOICE!" East day, from the 17<sup>th</sup> to Christmas Eve, is given its individual date in the Missed and Lectionary used at Mass.

In Phase 1 of Advent, the days ere just listed as 'Thursday of the 2<sup>nd</sup> weeks of Advent', for example – since the theme of that much longer phase was Preparation – (especially marked by injunctions such as "Watch!" and "Stay awake!")

So, Advent has a real, discernible structure. We can make its stability work to our advantage – especially in a situation of instability presently, marked today with the arrival of Plan B' restrictions – much broader wearing of face coverings etc.
