## Fr Con's Reflection

Last Sunday (5<sup>th</sup> June), we



celebrated the solemn feast of PENTECOST: The Descent of the Holy Spirit. ('Pentecost' is the Greek word for 50 i.e. He descended 50 days after Jesus' glorious Resurrection from the dead).

The Holy Spirit is the great mutual love between God the Father and God the Son. He is the 3<sup>rd</sup> Person of the Holy Trinity. His title is PARACLETE – from a Greek word meaning 'Helper'. He helps us as our Comforter and Consoler.

This coming Sunday (12<sup>th</sup> June) is Trinity Sunday. We praise the Holy Trinity in the 'Gloria' prayer at Sunday Mass, and in the short well-known "Glory be..." prayer.

In addition, of course, we praise them with the sign of the cross which begins and ends formal prayers. Let us always make this sign well and encourage our children to always do the same.
