School Street

The Council is planning on making part of Dunley Drive a 'School Street'.

I am so pleased that Good Shepherd has been chosen to join the growing number of schools who already benefit from this system —it is a great way of making Dunley Drive a much safer place for all our children.

This would mean that parents could not park on Dunley Drive from 8:00-9:30 or from 2-4pm on school days and would have to park further afield or choose a more sustainable means of travel to school such as walking or scooting.

The reason for this new initiative is to reduce problems with traffic, congestion and air pollution around the school.


