Good Shepherd children did a brilliant job of showcasing their religious knowledge and came first in the quiz which was on the liturgical year and the Bible.




I received some lovely message in our visitors book from visiting staff:







Good Shepherd Day


The children spent yesterday moving around the school taking part in lots of different activities for our Feast Day.

Children listened to the story of the Lost Sheep and were reminded that Jesus loves and cares for us no matter what we do.



Fr Con's Reflection

This coming Sunday, 28th May, is the solemn Feast of PENTECOST.



It is 50 days after Easter Sunday ('Pentecost' is the Greek word for 50).

The Feast celebrates the Descent of the Holy Spirit. This occurred 10 days after Jesus' Ascension to God the Father's right hand. The Holy Spirit is that great mutual love that exists between God the Father and God the Son. So, He is the very love that is God. (He was fully received at Baptism, and later at Confirmation which takes its name from its direct link with Baptism).

A truly great Feast, followed the day after by the Whitsun Bank Holiday.
