Parent/Guardians of children aged between 4 years and 11 years old can come along if they have any questions between 12:00-14:00 and bring along the Red book or any vaccination records from abroad.

Fr Con's Reflection

This Sunday is the great solemn
Feast of CORPUS CHRISTI (the
Body and Blood of the Lord)- the
Feast of Holy Communion- (the Holy
Eucharist/ the Blessed Sacrament).

At the Last Supper, when Jesus said "THIS IS MY BODY. THIS IS MY BLOOD", that is precisely what the bread and wine became while He was still in the Upper Room with His Apostles, there and then.

St. Maximillian Kolbe, the Saint of Auschwitz Concentration Camp (WW2), famously said that if Angels envied humans in a single respect, it would be concerning Holy Communion. (Angels never received it as they were never earthlings, but always in God's Presence.)
