Due to time constraints, older children will need to bring in a short story book, poetry book, book of prayers or nonfiction book as there will not be time to read a long


chapter book every day.

#### Fr Con's Reflection

This Sunday is the Solemnity (or Solemn Feast) of 'CHRIST THE KING' – The final Sunday of the Church's Year. It is always the 33<sup>rd</sup> or 34<sup>th</sup> Sunday of the Church's Calendar- the numeral is dependent on the date of Easter, which itself is dependent on the moon and the tides.

As King, Jesus is a Royal Shepherd of His People, leading them to the Kingdom of His Father. He is the Good Shepherd and this is reflected in the 1<sup>st</sup> Reading and Gospel at the coming Sunday's Mass.

So, the title 'CHRIST THE KING' has a particularly close significance for both our school and parish.

May we find time this Sunday to commit to Jesus, the Good Shepherd, all connected with our school and all its daily activities and concerns.
