Fr Con's Reflection

Very early on this Sunday morning (March 30th), British Summer Time (BST) replaces Greenwich Mean Time (GMT). Accordingly, clocks and watches etc need to go <u>FORWARD</u> one-hour, last thing on Saturday night.

Sunday is also <u>Mother's Day.</u> In Church terms, it always coincides with 'LAETARE' Sunday.

'Laetare' is a Latin exhortation meaning "REJOICE!" it is seen as a relaxation day for Lenten penance.

This Sunday is also the start of Passiontide fortnight, when crosses and statues in church are covered in purple. The purpose of this is to lead us inward and deeper, away from the mere externals.
