This coming Sunday is CORPUS CHRISTI, the Solemn Feast of Holy Communion (the Blessed Sacrament, the Holy Eucharist).



20 children will be receiving Jesus for the first time- the Bread of Life, the Living Bread. Seven of these are from our school:

OSCAR (YEAR 4); SIENNA, NATALIO, GABRIELLA, ZOFIA, CLEMENCE and EMMA (all in Year 3).

Sunday will be the final one of 3 major Feasts (consecutive ones, this month), for June 8th was PENTECOST (the Descent of the Holy Spirit) and June 15th was TRINITY SUNDAY.
