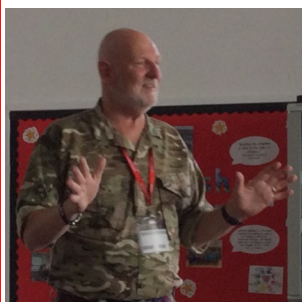


## Visitors to Good Shepherd

This coming Sunday is CORPUS CHRISTI, the Solemn Feast of Holy Communion (the Blessed Sacrament, the Holy Eucharist).



20 children will be receiving Jesus for the first time- the Bread of Life, the Living Bread. Seven of these are from our school:

OSCAR (YEAR 4); SIENNA, NATALIO, GABRIELLA, ZOFIA, CLEMENCE and EMMA (all in Year 3).

Sunday will be the final one of 3 major Feasts (consecutive ones, this month), for June 8<sup>th</sup> was PENTECOST (the Descent of the Holy Spirit) and June 15<sup>th</sup> was TRINITY SUNDAY.

The Holy Trinity is the greatest of all Mysteries. It is a heavenly phenomenon. No-one can explain it. The 3 Persons in God are separate and yet dwell in each other.
