## Fr Con's Reflection



Thursday of this school week, May 14<sup>th</sup>, was the Solemn Feast of the ASCENSION OF THE LORD – the return of the Risen Jesus to God the Father's right hand in Heaven.

The Ascension of Jesus was 40 days on from His Glorious Resurrection on the first Easter Sunday.

When the Ascension occurs on its rightful day (a Thursday), it opens for us a 9-day novena period of prayer for the annual Commemoration of the Descent of the Holy Spirit.

He is the Paraclete (meaning "Helper") – the true Presence of God with us to the end of time – our Consoler and Comforter on our journey to God.
