Speech and language is about understanding and talking. These are the most complex skills we ever learn.

For most children, speech and language develops with no trouble, through interacting with the people around them. However, a significant group of children struggle to develop these skills.

Croydon families with children aged 5 years old and under (under school reception age) who have concerns about their child's talking or interaction can visit The Chatterbox Groups. At Good Shepherd our nearest group is at The Woodland's Children Centre every Thursday 1:00-2:30.

These groups are play-based and a speech and language therapist is present to offer advice and support.

Please remember early identification and support is key.
