Attendance

Here are some things parents can do to help their child maintain good attendance levels:

- Book medical appointments outside of school hours where possible. Where this isn't possible, they should bring their child to school before, and return afterwards.
- Vaccinations are a key line of defence against flu and other preventable illnesses.
 When children receive all the recommended vaccines, it helps protect their health and support the wellbeing of the whole school community.

But remember that handwashing is a simple but powerful tool. Hand hygiene is one of the most effective ways to prevent the spread of germs, particularly those that cause diarrhoea or vomiting. Encourage your child to

- Wash their hands for at least 20 seconds using soap and water.
- Use tissues for coughs and sneezes then throw them in the bin.
- Avoid touching their face, particularly their eyes, nose and mouth.

By following these simple steps, you can help ensure your child stays healthy and enjoys a successful school term.

The NHS provides clear guidance on when children are well enough to attend school. Most mild illnesses, such as a runny nose, sore throat, or slight cough, do **not** require time off school.
