On Thursday of this week (March 25th), we celebrated the great solemn feast of the Annunciation the Lord.

Next week is Holy Week, the 2nd half of which comprises the Sacred Triduum, the holiest 3 days of the Christian Calendar:

Maundy Thursday evening: the Mass of the Lord's Supper.

Good Friday 3pm: the Service of the Lord's Passion.

Holy Saturday night: the Easter Vigil.

Let us approach Easter Sunday in a spirit of humble thanksgiving to God, for sending His Only Begotten Son to earth for our salvation.
