On Wednesday 28th June at 2:30pm the school will gather on the field for the race finals and the parent races.

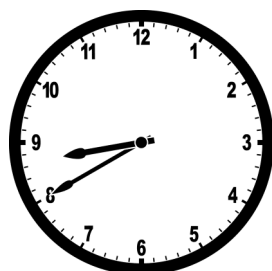
Your class teacher will give you a letter if your child is running on this day.
