Visit the Library this Summer

'Ready, Set, Read!' is the reading challenge theme this year – encouraging children to experience the thrill of sports and the power of teamwork through reading.

Taking part in the challenge and registration are simple – children can visit their local library and start their adventure by reading six books throughout the summer. Each participant will receive a fold-out poster and can collect stickers along the way to track their progress.

In addition to the fun-filled theme, Croydon's libraries are holding a prize draw, open to all who successfully complete the challenge. The prizes include a Kindle tablet, a voucher for Flip Out Croydon and an exclusive tour of Selhurst Park.

If your child is not already a member of a library, parents/carers needs to take one official document with their current name and address on it (such as a driving licence, allowance book or bank statement) to any Croydon library, and your child will be issued with a membership card.

Free Lunches for Children

The Mayor of London is ensuring all primary school children in London receive free school meals, starting in September.

Your child will receive their free school meal automatically regardless of your circumstances, but it's really important to still complete the Government's registration form for Pupil Premium in case your child is eligible for extra funding for our school from the Government. This is worth £1,455 per year. Your child will also benefit from free educational visits, reduced cost clubs and additional support in class. The registration process is straightforward and confidential. Further information about registration can be found by the emailing the school.
