

Keeping children safe

The <u>Parents Protect! website</u> has plenty of information and resources on how to keep children safe from sexual abuse. They have put together <u>a list of useful resources</u> that can help you bring up issues such as how to be safe online and consent.



There are videos and guides available from the NSPCC website designed for parents and carers to use with young children to help keep them safe, including the Pantosaurus video and The Underwear Rule that teach children that their body belongs to them and they have a right to say no.
